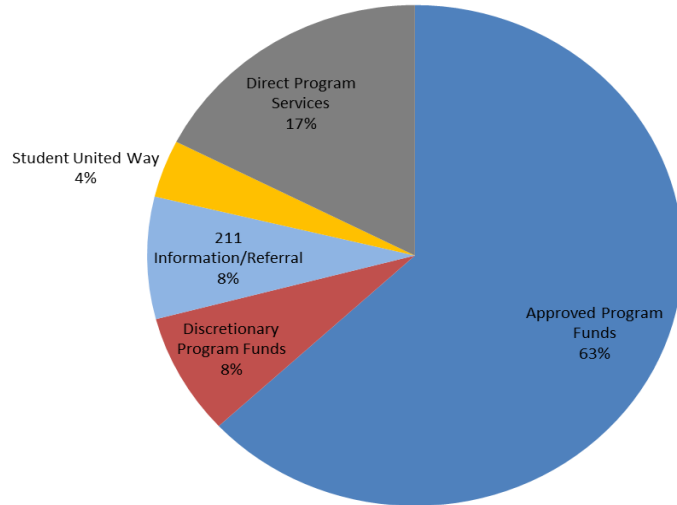


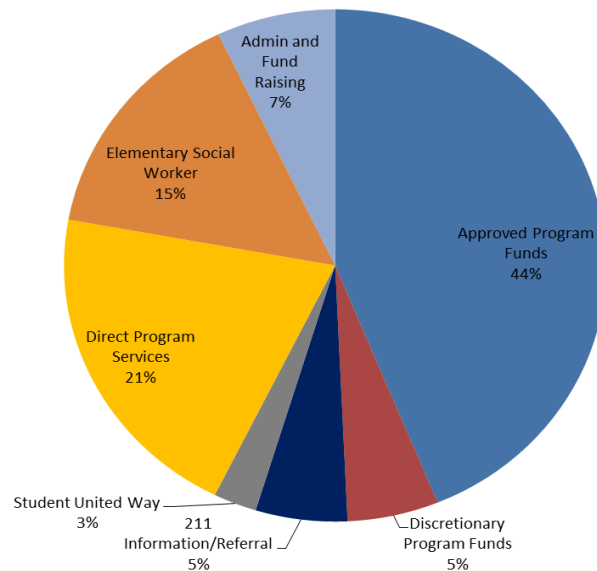
2017 United Way Campaign Fund Distribution

Mission Statement: The United Way of the Titusville Region is committed to being the driving force in improving the lives of people in the region, through actions that address and reduce the community’s human service needs.

Organizational Activities and Accomplishments

- Successful completion of annual fund drive with a record \$203,016 raised to support our mission.
- Continuation of the Center for Financial Independence program promoting financial stability (total families served 503)
- Providing Elementary Social Work in cooperation with the Titusville Area School District.
- Successfully lead Crawford County in the establishment of the 2-1-1 Social Services information and referral system
- Advised THS Student United Way in local activities and coordinated the Ecuador Service Trip
- Approved by PA DCED to administer Educational Improvement Tax Credit as a Pre-K Scholarship Organization. 54 early learners received \$27,500 in Pre-K tuition scholarships.
- Establishment of the Thrive Women’s Initiative in collaboration with the YWCA
- Member of the Titusville Area School District Coordinated School Health Council
- Member of the Titusville Area School District Act 48 committee.
- Member of Crawford County Health Improvement Coalition, and Titusville Community Council
