**Bed Tenants expectations:**

- All Garden Tenants must complete the rental agreement to be considered
- Make full payment for rental fees
- Provide workers to tend your assigned bed
- Ensure all David's Garden Rules of the Rows are followed
- May bring your own tools
- Clean up before you leave
- After 8:00 PM, you are responsible for locking the gate
- Tools must be put away when you are finished, the garden cart should be left with the bed upright to allow for drainage

**UWTR/David's Garden deliverables:**

- Provide training for garden management
- Provide a David's Garden Bed Manager for assistance and management
- Provide keys or passcodes for gates and garden shed
- Garden hose and some tools will be provided for use
- Gather data on harvests for grant purposes
- Two one-season scholarships for bed rental will be provided by the Garden Committee

If a non -profit wants to grow food for their programs, (i.e., food distribution, food insecure clients, etc.) they may do so at the approval of the committee.

David L. Weber Memorial Community Garden Rules

1. The bed tenant will be responsible for providing all plants or seedlings; however no invasive species are permitted. (If you have a question, please contact the garden manager.)
2. Your plot should be planted by June 12<sup>th</sup> and cleaned up by October 30<sup>th</sup>. You are responsible for planting, weeding, watering. Keep your plot and the area around it clean and weed free.
3. You are responsible for your bed only. Leave the other plots alone unless you were given permission by the bed tenant or the garden manager.
4. Clean up after yourself. If you used the shared hose and tools, put them away when you are finished. If you bring your own tools, take them with you when you go.
5. Children are permitted with supervision. Please make sure they do not disturb other beds and are respectful of the space.
6. Pets are not allowed inside the gate. There will be an area for leashed pets, outside of the gate. Please clean up after your pet as necessary.
7. No chemicals or manufactured fertilizers are permitted. If you would like to add additional organic matter and soil nutrients, please contact the garden manager first. The soil in your garden plot will have been amended with leaves, organic soil mix, etc. and ready for planting.
